In this book series, we encourage researchers to share in details how they approached their data analysis, what role did theory play in their analysis and how, what kind of ethical issues did they have to address, what specific processes did they use for making sense of their data, and what new insights were they able to discover as a result of their chosen analytic approach(es).

If the researcher had to break rank with traditional approaches to qualitative data analysis or reconfigure a familiar approach in a new way, then that work is of tremendous interest to us. The

emphasis of this series is to offer narrative details of qualitative data analysis process with examples, while creating new methodological and substantive knowledge.

Authors from any discipline may submit a proposal. We are looking for authors at any stage of their career as we want to focus on creating spaces for scholars who might not have a centered space within qualitative research. Authors working from non-dominant perspectives are especially encouraged to submit a proposal.

We accept proposals from 50,000 and 80,000 words individually or jointly authored works. Authors should identify their data analysis approach(es) within a specific empirical study focusing on theory, methods, analysis, representation, and ethics. Authors should make arguments about how their approach to data analysis contributes to qualitative inquiry as a discipline and its associated implications.
